

Raceview State School is a school which values respect and has high behavioural expectations of each student.

We are an SWPBS school which means that we promote positive school wide behaviour across all settings in the school. SWPBS stands for **Schoolwide Positive Behaviour Support**.

At Raceview State School our expectations are **Be a SPORT** and always demonstrate the SPORTy behaviours at school.

S-Self Control **P**-Persistence **O**-Organisation **R**-Respect **T**-Team Player

Each week there is a whole school behaviour focus and the teachers explicitly teach a lesson that goes with the weekly focus.

At Raceview State School, positive behaviours are rewarded by giving out tokens that we call 'Trophies'.



The 'Trophies' are collected by the students and glued into an exercise book. These 'Trophies' can then be spent in our Rewards Room. The Rewards Room is a room that has a variety of different rewards that students can choose to spend their 'Trophies' on.

Raceview State School students are also rewarded on assembly with armbands as they reach certain milestones with their 'Trophy' collection.
