Raceview State School will receive

\$546,974*

This funding will be used to

- Improve the percentage of students achieving in the Upper Two Bands (U2B) in reading in Year 3 to Year 5 from 47.3% to 50.0%.
- Improve the percentage of students achieving in the U2B in Reading in Year 5 from 27.2% to 30.0%.
- Improve writing in Year 5 – Band 6, 7 and 8 from 20.9% to 25.0%.
- Improve U2B in writing in Year 3 from 31.7% to 35.0%.
- Extend targeted academic intervention in writing to ensure all eligible students in Year 3 and Year 5 meet the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in NAPLAN writing.
- Establish a teaching team to use an inquiry cycle approach to drive student improvement in writing.
- Improve student attendance rates from 91.8% to meet or exceed the state-wide average of 92.8%.
- Increase opportunities for parents to participate in school activities from 86.2% to greater than 89.0%, as measured by the School Opinion Survey.

Our initiatives include

- Appointing Science Teachers to support Teachers in Prep to Year 6 and to implement Australian curriculum science Prep to 6. Providing demonstrations lesson and feedback on teaching practice.
- Appointing a second Head of Curriculum to develop the Australian Curriculum Teaching Teams in Years Prep to 3.
- Developing the capabilities of the school leadership team in the inquiry cycle to lead the development of professional learning teams of teacher.
- Developing a whole school attendance strategy using an action research approach facilitated by the Dean of Students.
- Increasing parent community participation by extending opportunities for parent governance and decision making in the school by involving parent groups, community members and staff.

Employing a writing Teacher to build teacher capacity across Prep to 3 and Years 4 to 6 to support the teaching of writing.	\$85,470
Employing a Dean of Students to drive the implementation of Positive Behaviour Support across the school and the improvement of student attendance.	\$115,000
Providing additional speech language support by increasing the	\$98,936


