The Defence School Transition Aide Program provides support to children of Australian Defence Force (ADF) members and their families, particularly during transition into and out of school, on posting or during parental absences due to deployment, exercises or courses.

What Does a DSTA do?

- Assist ADF parents and children to become familiar with the school and it's facilities
- Co-ordinates appropriate welcoming and farewelling activities
- Supports children at school during times of parental absences from home for service requirements
- Contributes items of interest to newsletters
- Provides opportunities for ADF families to meet other ADF families within the school community
- Maintains contact with ADF families who are enrolled in the school
