It helps your child to listen and learn at school.

Raceview State School would like to check your child's hearing. This is a free service: your child will play a hearing game called **Sound Scouts** on an iPad using special headphones. It uses a third-party cloud service (within Australia) to report on your child's hearing. After the check, the school will send you a copy of the report.

Sound Scouts requires some information about your child to conduct the test. This includes:

- ✓ name
- ✓ month and year of birth
- ✓ year level
- ✓ gender
- ✓ cultural/language background
- ✓ school name and postcode
